

IUPUC Admission-Based Scholarships

Admission-based scholarships are automatic awards in recognition of the academic achievements of graduating high school students who attend IUPUC the fall after graduation. By rewarding excellence through scholarships, we hope to encourage students to continue their education at IUPUC.

To qualify for scholarships, students must be admitted to IUPUC by February 1. While some students may meet the qualifications for multiple admission-based scholarships, they will receive only the largest admission-based scholarship (i.e. highest dollar amount) for which they are eligible.

Official transcripts may be submitted after fall grades post during your final year of high school, if GPA has increased. Increased SAT/ACT scores will be accepted until April 1.



IUPUC Hoosier Presidential Scholarship

\$8,500 annually/four years

High school seniors with a minimum of 3.9/4.0 cumulative GPA and a minimum 1360 math/critical reading SAT or 29 ACT (CO) may qualify. For renewal, student must be enrolled full-time (12 credit hours or more) at IUPUC, maintain a minimum 3.5 CGPA and volunteer at one pre-approved campus event per semester.

Vice Chancellor's Honors Scholarship

\$6,000 annually/four years

High school seniors with a minimum of 3.75/4.0 cumulative GPA, with minimum 1320 math/critical reading SAT or 28 ACT (CO), and participate in the IUPUC Honor's Program may qualify. For renewal, student must be enrolled full-time (12 credit hours or more) at IUPUC, maintain a minimum 3.3 CGPA, continue in the IUPUC Honors Program, and volunteer at one pre-approved campus event per semester.

Academic Excellence Scholarship

\$4,000 annually/four years

High school seniors with minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5/4.0 and a minimum 1220 math/critical reading SAT or 25 ACT (CO) may qualify. For renewal, student must be enrolled full-time (12 credit hours or more) at IUPUC, maintain a minimum 3.0 CGPA, and volunteer at one pre-approved campus event per semester.

Service Scholarship

\$2,750 annually/four years

High school seniors with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.3/4.0 and a minimum 1140 math/critical reading SAT or 23 ACT (CO) may qualify. For renewal, student must be enrolled full-time (12 credit hours or more) at IUPUC, maintain a minimum 3.0 CGPA, and volunteer at one pre-approved campus event per semester.

High School Counselor Recognition Scholarship

\$2,000 annually/four years

High school seniors with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.2/4.0 and a minimum 1110 math/critical reading SAT or 22 ACT (CO) may qualify. Recipients must be nominated by their school counselor. For renewal, student must be enrolled full-time (12 credit hours or more) at IUPUC, maintain a minimum 3.0 CGPA, and volunteer at one pre-approved campus event per semester.

First Generation Scholarship

\$1,500 annually/four years

High school seniors who are the first in family of origin (mother/father/legal guardian) to attend college/university minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0/4.0 and 1070 math/critical reading SAT or 21 ACT (CO) may qualify. For renewal, student must be enrolled full-time (12 credit hours or more) at IUPUC, maintain a minimum 3.0 CGPA, and volunteer at one pre-approved campus event per semester.
